<u>PURPOSE:</u>	Pursuant to a bond resolution adopted by the Village Board of Trustees on May 10, 2011 authorizing the issuance of \$4,400,000 of serial bonds for the construction of certain sewer system improvements.
<u>SECURITY AND SOURCE OF PAYMENT:</u>	The Notes are general obligations of the Village and will contain a pledge of the faith and credit of the Village for the payment of the principal thereof and the interest thereon. For the payment of such principal and interest, the Village has the power and statutory authorization to levy <i>ad valorem</i> taxes on all the taxable real property in the Village, without limitation as to rate or amount (subject to certain statutory limitations imposed by Chapter 97 of the 2011 Laws of New York).

Each bid must be for all of the Notes and must state a single rate of interest therefor in a multiple of one-eighth (1/8th) or one-hundredth (1/100th) of one per centum (1%) per annum. Unless all bids are rejected, the Notes will be awarded to the bidder offering to purchase the Notes at the lowest net interest cost, that being the rate of interest which will produce the least interest cost over the life of the Notes, after accounting for the premium offered, if any. In any event, the award of the Notes will be made on the basis of the bid offering to purchase the Notes on terms most favorable to the Village. If two or more bidders offer to purchase the Notes at the same lowest net interest cost, the Notes will be awarded to one of such bidders selected by the Village Treasurer by lot from among all such bidders. The right is reserved to reject all bids,

and any bid not complying with this Notice of Sale will be rejected. Interest will be computed on the basis of 30 days to the month and 360 days to the year.

PAYMENT TO BE MADE IN FEDERAL FUNDS. THE PURCHASER SHALL HAVE THE OPTION OF HAVING THE NOTES ISSUED AS PHYSICAL CERTIFICATES OR IN THE FORM OF BOOK-ENTRY-ONLY NOTES REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF CEDE & CO., AS NOMINEE FOR THE DEPOSITORY TRUST COMPANY [DTC]. THE NOTES WILL BE ISSUED IN REGISTERED FORM IN DENOMINATIONS OF \$5,000, OR INTEGRAL MULTIPLES THEREOF, AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY SUCH PURCHASER. FOR NOTES REGISTERED TO THE PURCHASER, A SINGLE NOTE CERTIFICATE WILL BE ISSUED.
